



## RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

Equality Ohio Education Fund, a statewide equal rights organization commissioned research to see where Ohio voters really stand on gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgendered (GLBT) issues.

1. Research conducted by The Glengariff Group, Inc. headquartered in Chicago, Illinois
2. Survey conducted from November 13-16, 2006
3. 800 registered Ohio voters were asked their views on a variety of GLBT rights issues
4. Margin of error +/- 3.5%

<u>Key Findings</u>	<u>Support</u>	<u>Oppose</u>
• Hospital visitation	91%	6%
• Ban employment/housing discrimination	68%	27%
• Inheritance rights	64%	29%
• Domestic partnership benefits for Government employees	58%	34%
• Equal marriage rights	34%	58%

*(Note: Cross-tabulated numbers may not total 100% due to respondents that "refused" to respond to a particular section)*
